Technical Information

In order to have a smooth running and entertaining show we would appreciate it if we could have access to the following:

- A good-working sound system with a long cord microphone on a stand (no podium)
- A raised stage or riser, one foot high, measuring a minimum of 16'x16' width and length, WITH THREE SETS OF STEPS; DOWNSTAGE CENTER, DOWNSTAGE RIGHT, AND DOWNSTAGE LEFT so the audience can easily participate.
- One bar stool
- One small waist-high cocktail-size table, covered with a cloth and skirted.
- A wash of light on the stage (necessary for large audiences, optional for small groups).
- For large theaters, spotlight is needed.
- Also for large theaters, cassette tapes and a cue sheet will be given to the sound operator to run during the show. Tapes are not used in smaller shows.
- A piano will be used whenever possible, which should be tuned prior to event.

Technical information is general. Specific technical information will be supplied for individual venues.
